- There will be no discussion by any party on any matters related to pending litigation.
- The Chair has the discretion to limit comment time. Generally three (3) minutes per speaker is allotted. The Chair may allow additional time.
- Written statements are always welcome and copies will be provided to Inland Wetlands Commission members for review.
- Immediate replies to questions/concerns should not be expected at this session but may be provided at the discretion of the Chair.
