The BOH will not permit any expression of personal complaints or defamatory comments about BOH members nor against any person connected with the Town of Monroe Health Department Employees or any other individual, firm or corporation. There will be no response to comments related to pending litigation. The BOH Chairman has the discretion to limit comment time. Generally, three (3) minutes per speaker is allotted. The Chair may allow additional time. Written statements are always welcome and are always provided to BOH members. Immediate replies to questions/concerns should not be expected (Chairman's discretion). **Second Public Participation** is an opportunity to make comments or ask questions on those unresolved items in our agenda that are under Unfinished Business or New Business.
