

COVID-19 Pandemic Update June 3, 2021

- Monroe had only 1 new case in the past week, and our 2-week rolling case rate is now less than 5 cases per 100,000. Monroe is no longer listed in <u>any</u> alert level category (i.e., "gray" on the map), along with most of the state.
- As of yesterday's report, Monroe has had 1,415 cases, and 16 deaths, since the start of the pandemic.
- We will offer vaccination clinics on June 9th and June 16th. Adult walk-ins are welcome from 9am noon. Due to the significant drop in demand at our clinics, and continued availability from healthcare providers and pharmacies, we will be suspending our weekly vaccination clinics after June 16th. My sincere thanks to all the Town staff and volunteers who worked incredibly hard to staff over 30 vaccination clinics.
