### COVID-19 Pandemic Update June 11, 2021

- Monroe had 2 new case in the past week. The state reports that almost every town in Connecticut had less than 5 cases per 100,000 population, or less than 5 cases total, during the last two-week period.
- As of yesterday's report, Monroe has had 1,417 cases, and 16 deaths, since the start of the pandemic.
