COVID-19 Pandemic Update **November 24, 2021**

- As of last week, case rates in Monroe were up slightly, averaging of approximately 2½ new cases per day. The number of cases and positivity rate has continued to increase throughout the state, and I expect reports later this week to indicate a continued trend of increased cases. That said, the state is reporting that the current rate of hospitalization due to COVID-19 has not risen dramatically, as we experienced a year ago.
- All adults over age 18 are eligible to receive a booster dose six months after completing their initial vaccination series.
- The Monroe Health Department and Emergency Management Team will be conducting another booster dose vaccination clinic on Tuesday, November 30th. Scheduling for this clinic is through the VAMS system, and appointments are visible now.
- The COVID-19 page on the Town's website has links for vaccination options in Monroe and in the surrounding area, which includes area pharmacies and healthcare systems.
